- Activities must be quick, relevant and practical
- Images with text
- Micro level
- Quantifiable resources

Baby Boomers

- “Parents of the Digital Immigrants, Still in the Old Country”
- Use larger fonts
- Longer, in-depth, academic teaching style
- Allow them to share ideas and perspectives
- Off-line resources, with some online resources
- Macro and micro detail
- Credible resources
